CONTINUING EDUCATION UNITS AND OTHER CREDITS:

1. IEMA Training Credit – This conference qualifies hour for hour training credit to be applied towards the training requirements of 29 Ill. Adm.Code 301.510(b)(4) issued by IEMA. Emergency Management Agencies will also receive credit from IEMA for participation in the Tabletop Exercise/Simulation.

2. "Hazwoper" meets the USDOL/OSHA 29 CFR §1910.120 requirements for eight-hour annual refresher training. Students completing the course will be awarded a "Hazwoper card" documenting the fulfillment of this requirement. The Hazwoper card will be issued the same day at the completion of the course.

3. Attendees who participate in the Tabletop Drill will meet the criteria of an annual exercise/simulation for LEPC plans as long as a copy of their local LEPC plan is used and exercised.

4. CEV's for medical personnel are applied for from the Illinois Department of Health.
